

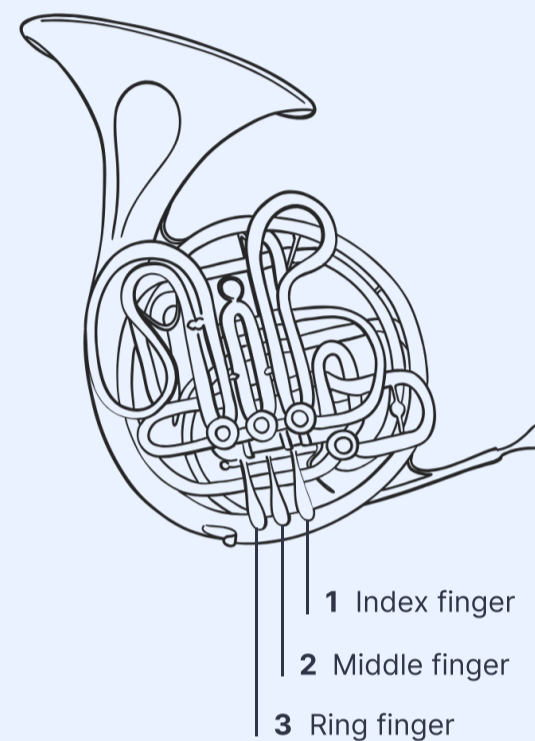
Horn in F fingering chart

How to read a fingering chart

The horn has three valves: 1, 2, and 3, as you can see in the image below.

The fingering chart indicates which valves you should press with numbers. The possible combinations are:

- 0 = no valves are pressed
- 1 = valve 1 is pressed
- 2 = valve 2 is pressed
- 3 = valve 3 is pressed
- 1 2 = valves 1 and 2 are pressed
- 1 3 = valves 1 and 3 are pressed
- 2 3 = valves 2 and 3 are pressed
- 1 2 3 = valves 1, 2 and 3 are pressed
