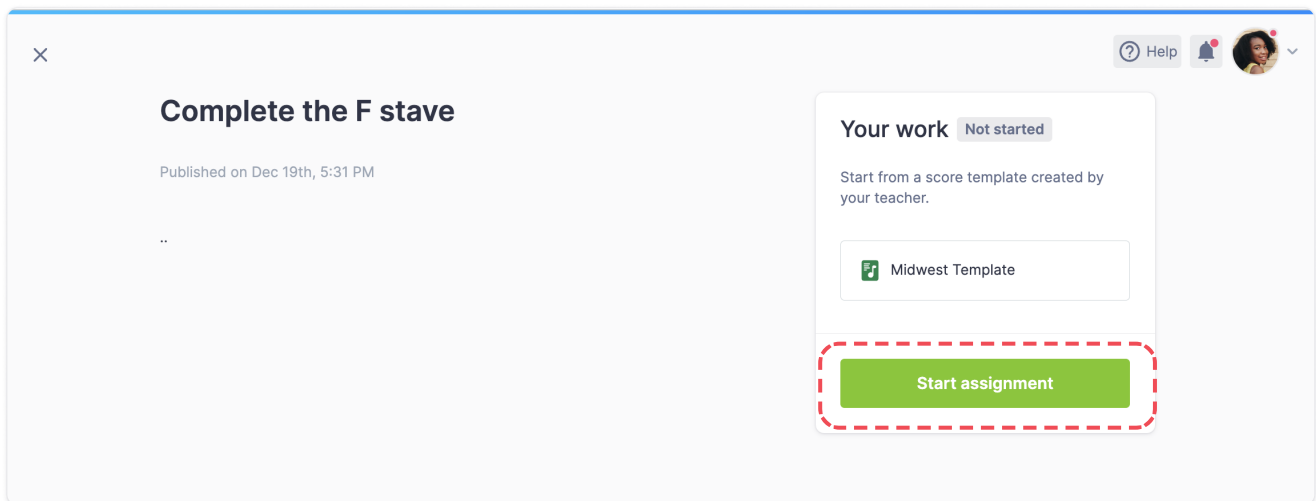

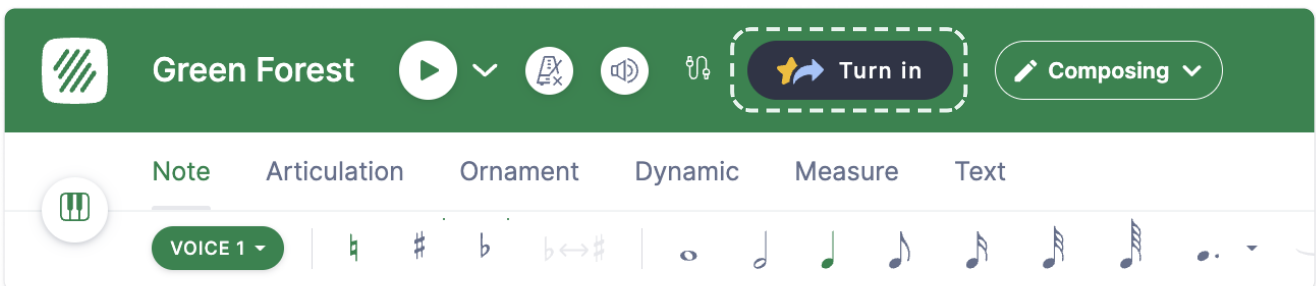
Start assignment

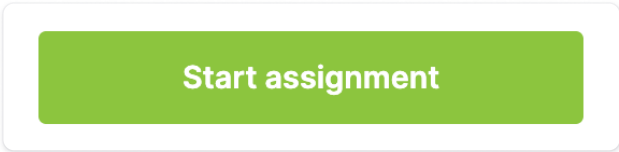




With performance assignments, you can record yourself playing an instrument or singing, and submit it to your teacher.

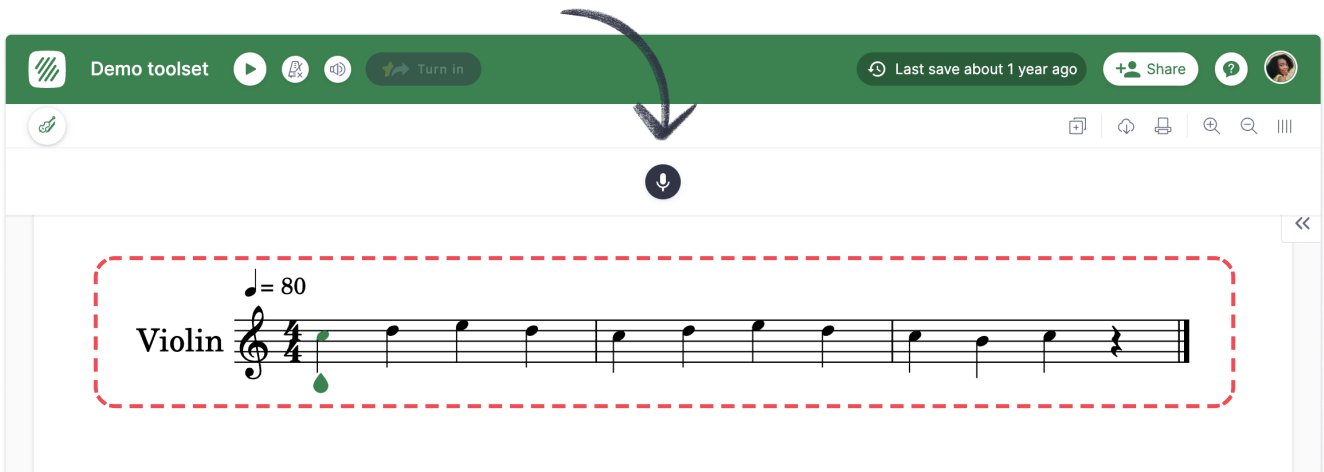
Start assignment

- 01. Playback the score before you start recording.



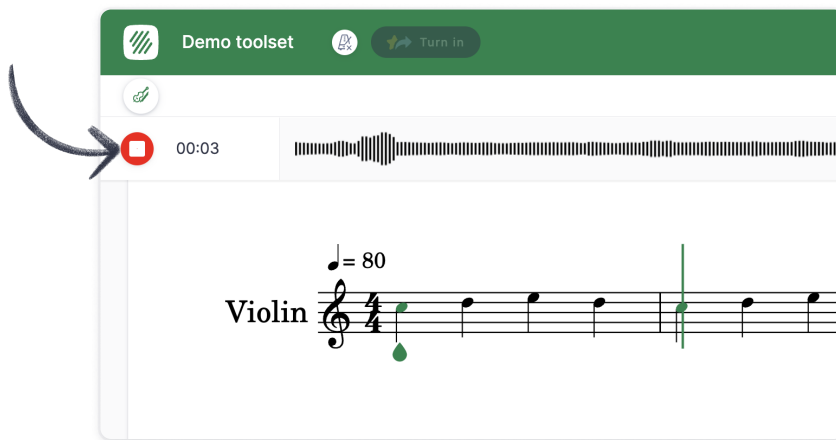
The score you are going to perform will be shown here.



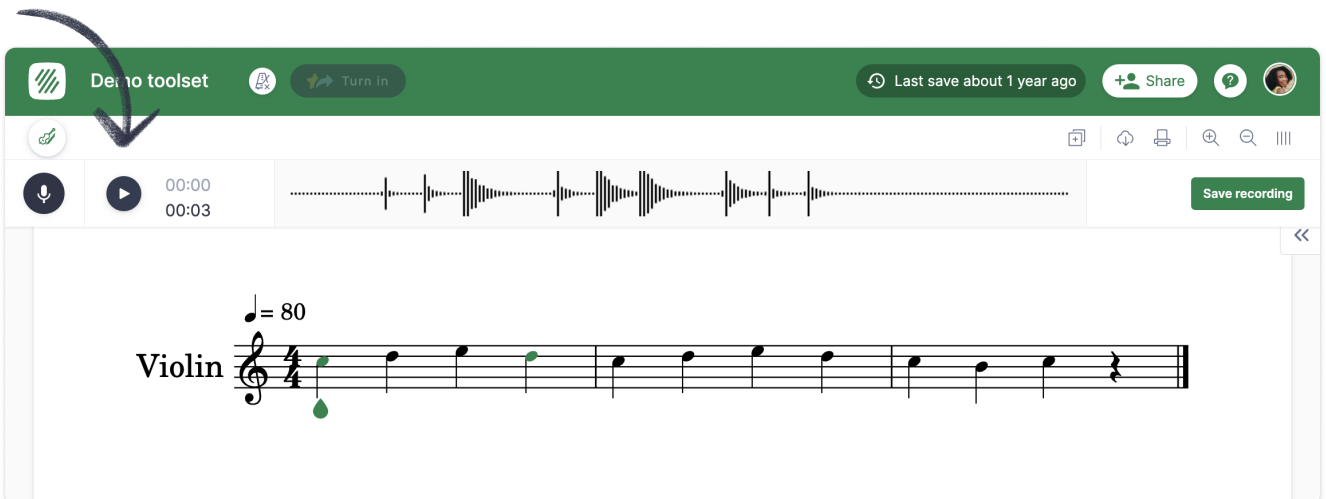
02. Click this button to start recording.

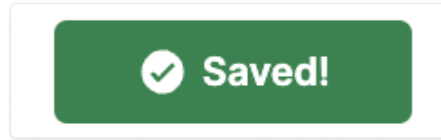

To submit your performance, click the turn in button at the top of the screen.



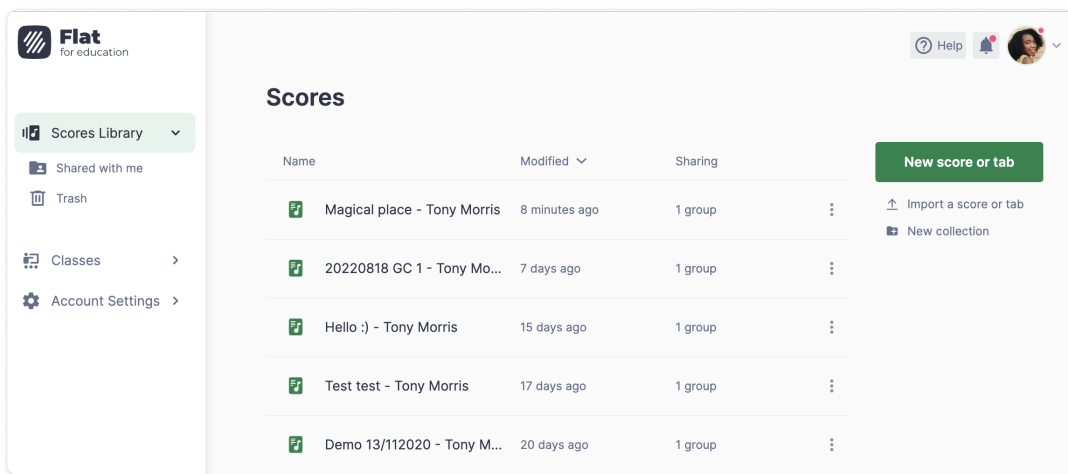

1. Open library

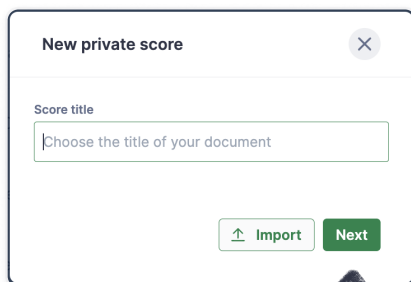


On your score library, you can create and manage scores.



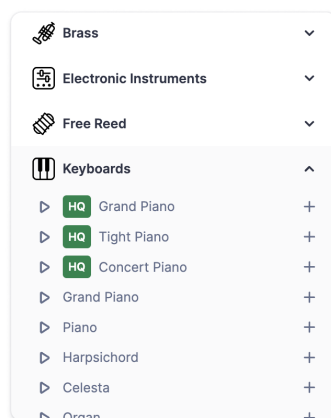
2. Create new score

Click **new score**.

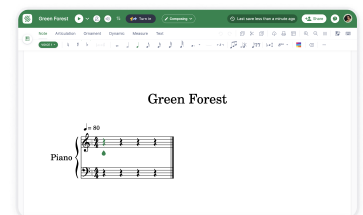

Input notes

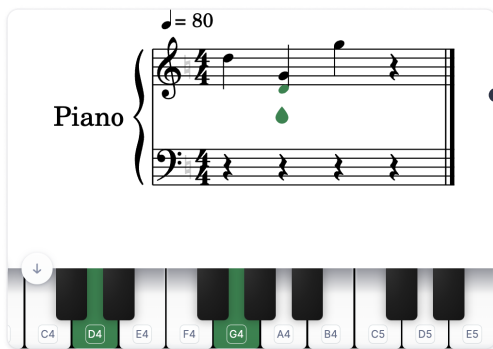
Cursor input



Move the cursor over the staff. A note will be added to the line or space where you click on.

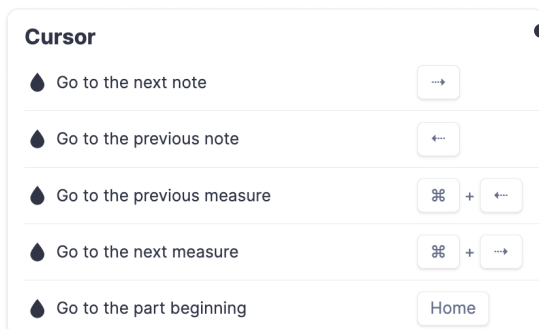


Piano keyboard input



Display virtual piano; you can input notes by clicking on the keyboard.

Shortcut input



If you want to input notes faster, use customisable shortcut keys.
